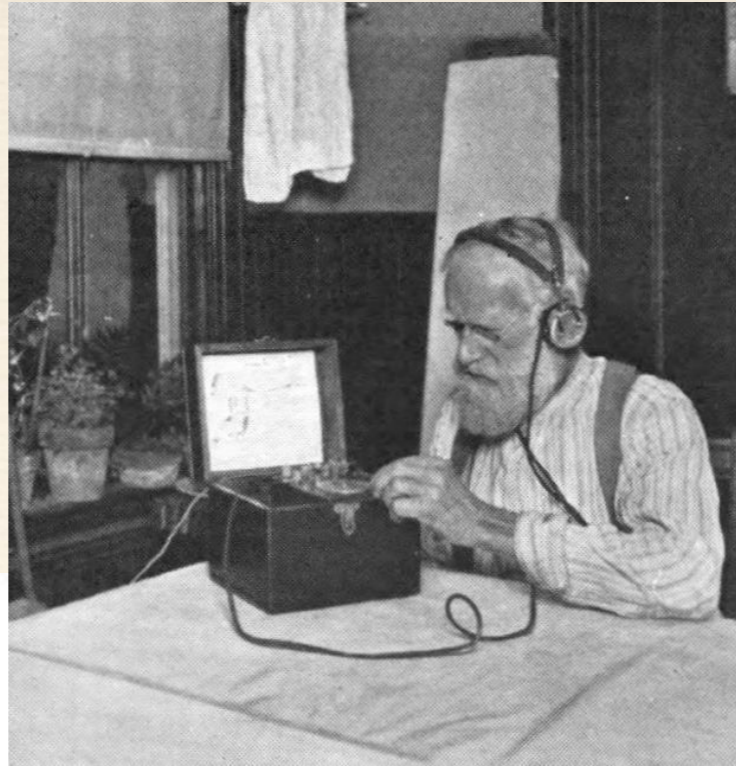

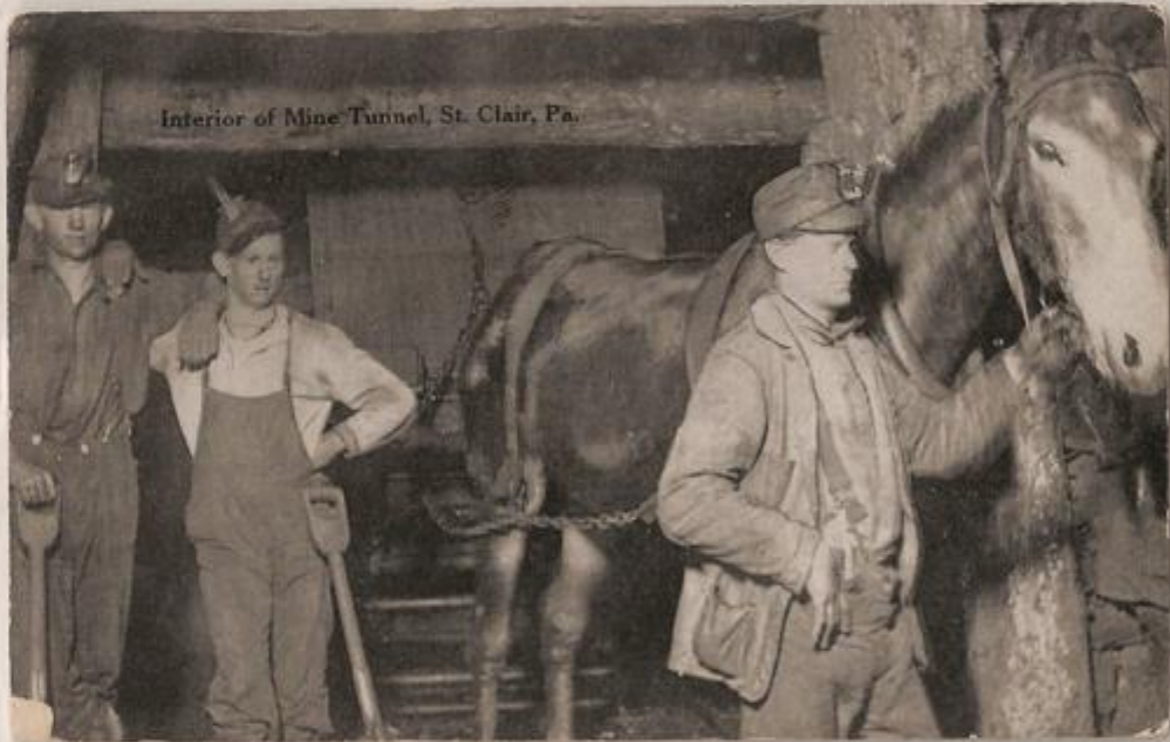

Interior of Mine Tunnel, St. Clair, Pa.



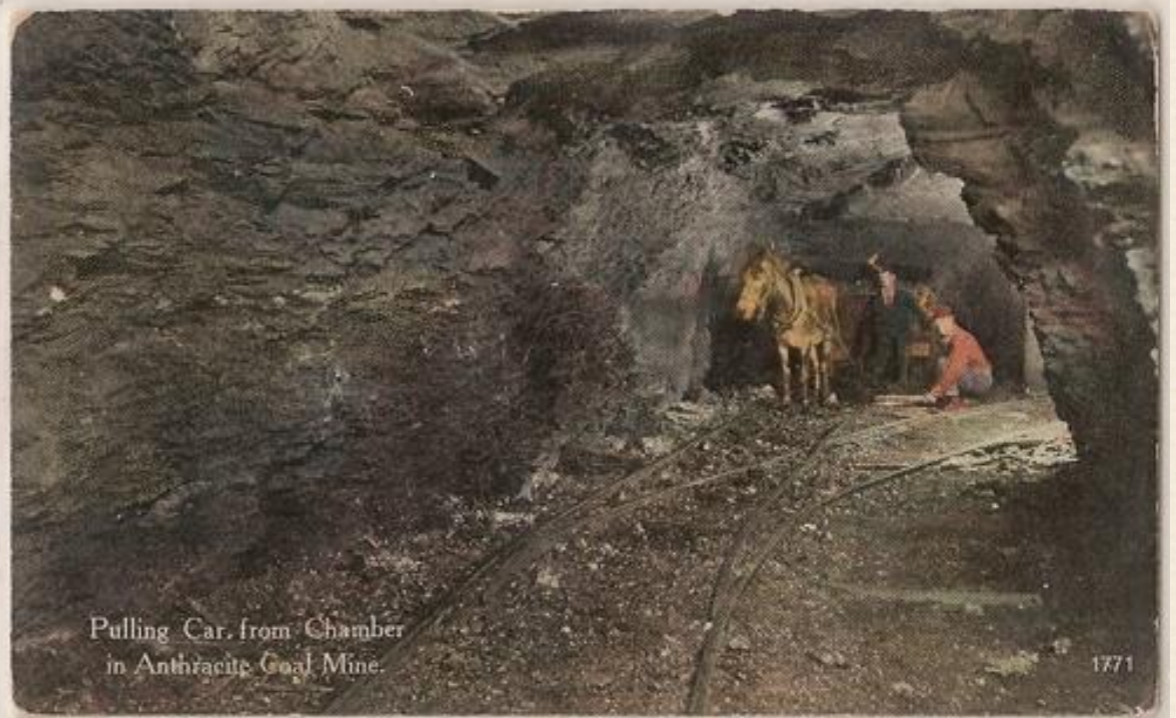
Coal Mining Near Hazleton, Pa.



A 1795 Coming out of Tunnel, "Homeward Bound"

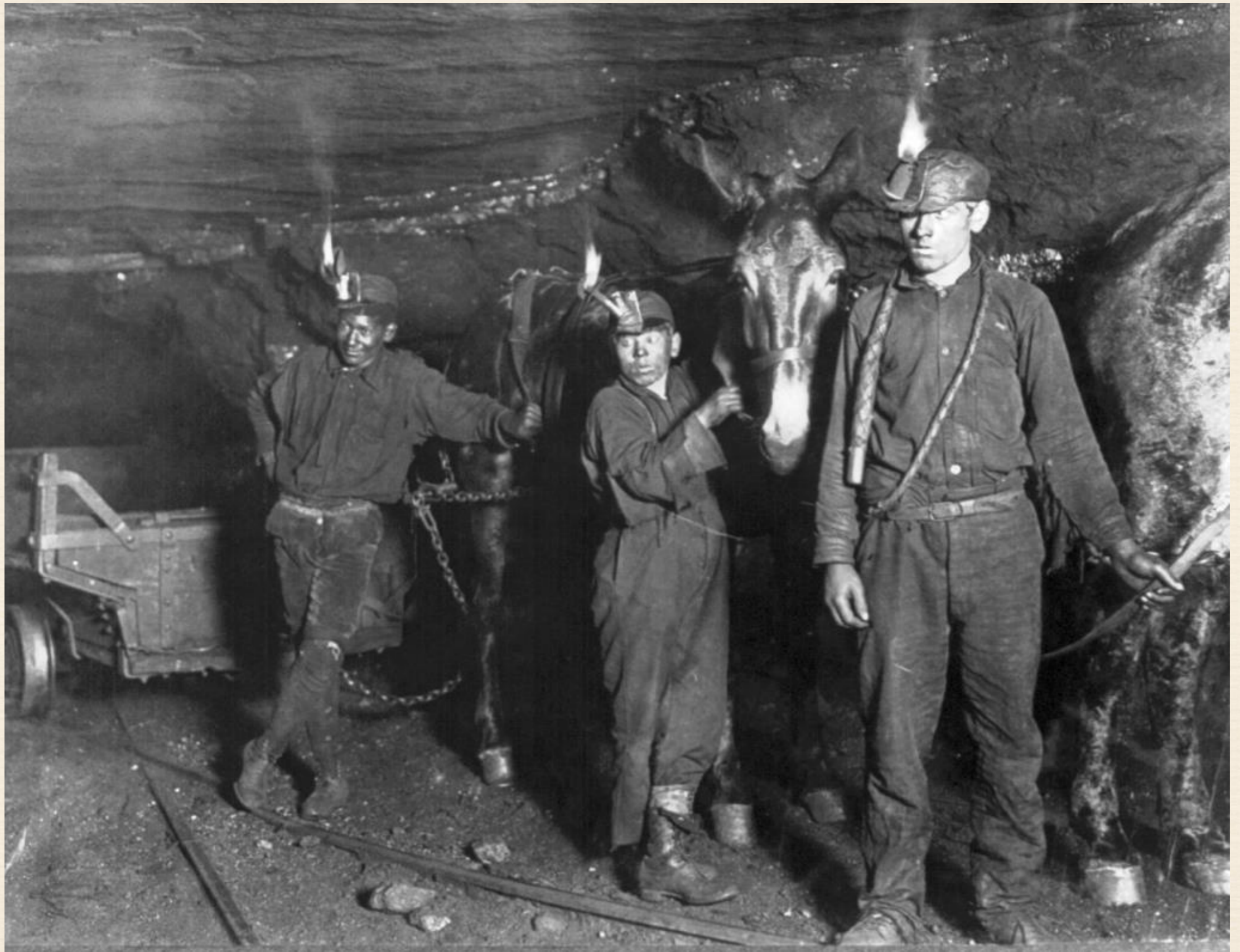

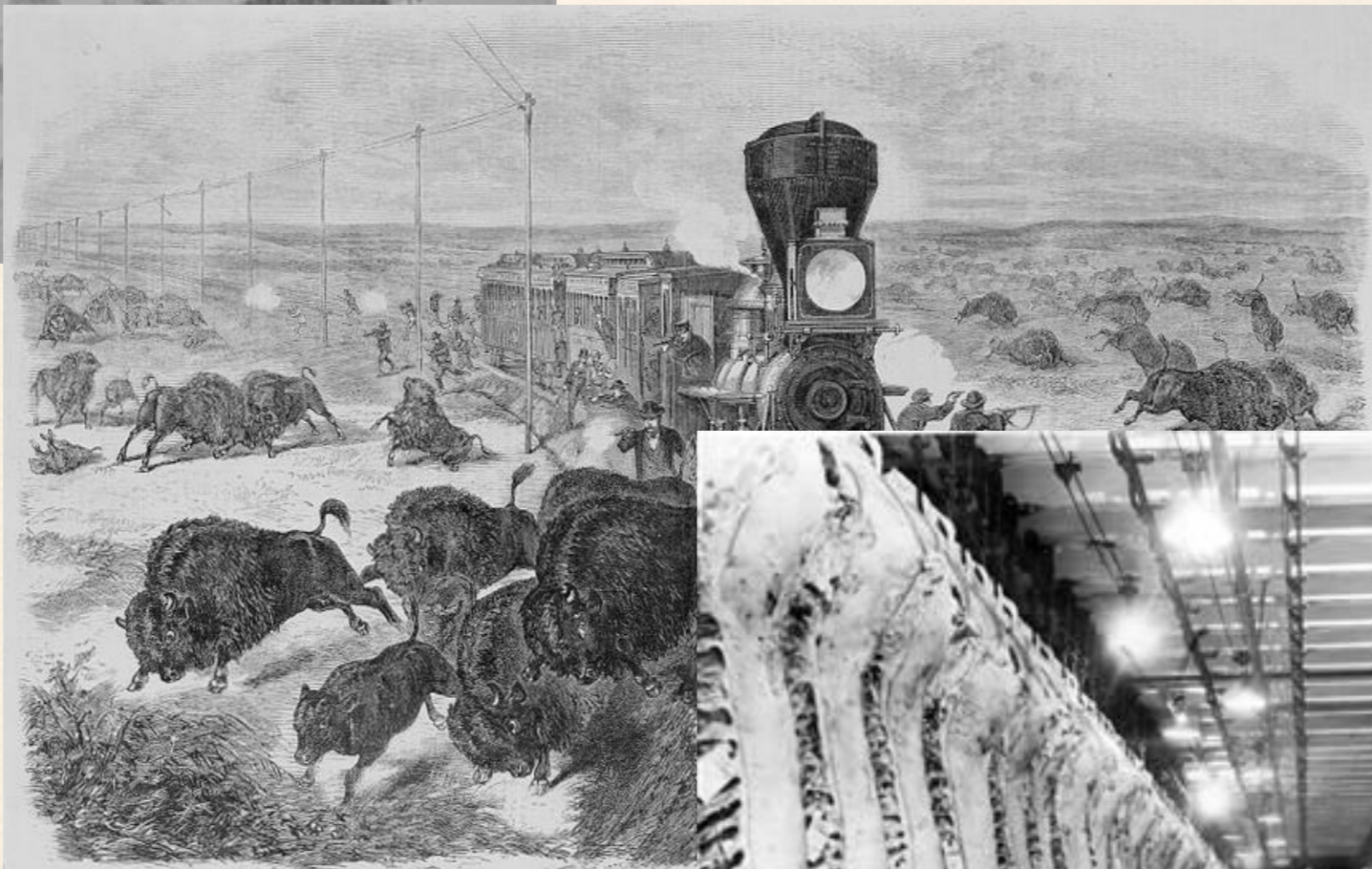
